Tips and Tricks



Keep a cool head. Glitches might happen, just save and refresh the page and 99% of the time, the problem is resolved!



Write all website text in a Google Doc or Word Doc. This helps in multiple ways: the text is in two places (just in case), use the Google or Word Doc word counter, helps to prevent typos.



When it doubt, use a flex box. If you don't like how something looks on your page, use a flex box.



This allows you to be flexible with alignment, sizing, and much more!

Create useful file names when uploading media. It's easier to find the images, videos, or sound clips you need, if you name the files something easy to remember. For example, if you want to use an image as your website background, name the image "Background."
